FRANK RUHSTALLER

BORN ON NOVEMBER 8, 1846, IN ENSLEDEIN, SWITZERLAND. RUHSTALLER MOVED TO THE UNITED STATES IN 1862 AT THE RIPE OLD AGE OF 15. PRIOR TO THAT, HE STUDIED BREWING IN THE CANTON BERNE. RUHSTALLER BECAME THE FOREMAN OF PAUL REISING'S BREWERY IN ST. ALBANY, INDIANA BEFORE HE WAS 18. HE MOVED TO CALIFORNIA WHERE HE GAINED EMPLOYMENT AT THE CITY BREWERY AND SIX WEEKS LATER, HE WAS MADE FOREMAN. HE THEN BOUGHT INTEREST IN OTHER BREWERIES; MOST NOTABLY WAS PACIFIC BREWERY WHERE HE SPENT AROUND THREE YEARS AS THE BREWER. HE ACQUIRED ENOUGH FUNDS TO BUY THE CITY BREWERY IN 1881, WHERE HE STAYED TIL HIS DEATH ON OCTOBER 28, 1907.

JEAN TALON

BORN ON JANUARY 8, 1626, IN CHÂLONS-EN-CHAMPAGNE. TALON ARRIVED IN THE COLONY OF NEW FRANCE IN 1665. IN 1668, HE FOUNDED A BREWERY. IT PRODUCED BEER FROM LOCAL RESOURCES: WATER, GRAIN (MOSTLY BARLEY BUT ALSO WHEAT AND A LITTLE RYE) AND HOPS, WHICH WERE PLANTED IN VAST FIELDS BELONGING TO TALON. TALON WAS OVERLY OPTIMISTIC IN HIS CORRESPONDENCE WITH THE KING OF FRANCE, HE CLAIMED THAT HIS BREWERY WOULD EVENTUALLY PRODUCE UP TO 4,000 BARRELS OF BEER A YEAR, AND THAT HALF OF THE PRODUCTION COULD BE EXPORTED TO THE WEST INDIES, OR EVEN EUROPE BUT THE BREWERY CLOSED ITS DOORS AFTER TEN YEARS.

FRANCISCO DE PAULA MARIN

BORN ON NOVEMBER 25, 1774, IN JEREZ DE LA FRONTERA, SPAIN WHO BECAME INFLUENTIAL IN THE EARLY KINGDOM OF HAWAII. HE ESTABLISHED HAWAII'S FIRST GRAPE VINEYARD IN 1815 AND PRODUCED ITS FIRST WINE AND BRANDY. HE DISTILLED SUGARCANE INTO RUM AND EXPERIMENTED WITH BEER AND ALTHOUGH WE MAY NOT KNOW A LOT ABOUT MARIN'S BREW, HE UNDOUBTEDLY CONTRIBUTED TO THE EVOLUTION OF HAWAII'S HISTORY WHILE SETTING THE STAGE FOR MODERN BEER BREWING LONG AFTER HIS DEATH ON OCTOBER 30, 1837.

WILLIAM STEINBERGER

WILLIAM STEINBERGER BECAME VICTORIA'S FIRST COMMERCIAL BREWER WHEN HE ESTABLISHED THE VICTORIA BREWERY IN 1858. STEINBERGER WAS FROM GERMANY AND HE CAME TO VICTORIA IN SEARCH OF HIS FORTUNE IN GOLD AND ENDED UP FOLLOWING THE PATH OF A GOLDEN LIQUID RATHER THAN THAT OF THE GOLDEN METAL HE CAME FOR. THE GOLD SEEKER TURNED BREWER SECURED A GRAIN SUPPLIER IN THE PUGET SOUND AGRICULTURAL COMPANY AT CRAIGFLOWER FARM. STEINBERGER SET UP HIS BREWERY, IN A SMALL LOG BUILDING, AT THE NEARBY SWAN LAKE, WHERE HE ALSO GREW HIS OWN HOPS.

DESNOES & GEDDES

DESNOES AND GEDDES LIMITED IS A JAMAICAN BREWER AND BEVERAGE PRODUCER FORMED IN 1918 BY EUGENE PETER DESNOES AND THOMAS HARGREAVES GEDDES WHO COMBINED THEIR TWO SHOPS INTO ONE BUSINESS. DESNOES AND GEDDES PRODUCES ONE OF JAMAICA'S BEST-KNOWN EXPORTS, RED STRIPE BEER, AND ALSO EXPORTS OLD JAMAICA GINGER BEER. IT BREWS OTHER MALT BEVERAGES FOR THE LOCAL MARKET UNDER THE BRAND NAMES RED STRIPE LIGHT, DRAGON STOUT, MALTA (NONALCOHOLIC), SMIRNOFF ICE, GUINNESS, AND HEINEKEN.

CHARLES JOHANN FUCHS

IN 1864 BAVARIAN SETTLER CHARLES JOHANN FUCHS ESTABLISHED THE FIRST OFFICIAL BREWERY OF GREECE CALLED FIX BREWERY IN ATHENS. FINDING BEER IN GREECE AMONG THIS TIME WAS A RARITY, AND WAS ONLY AVAILABLE WITHIN THE MAJOR CITIES. THE FIX BREWERY IS STILL AROUND TODAY AND OFFER A DARK LAGER, PREMIUM LAGER, AND AN ALCOHOL-FREE LAGER.

SAMUEL SMITH

THE BACKHOUSE & HARTLEY BREWERY WAS ESTABLISHED IN 1758 AND PURCHASED BY JOHN SMITH IN 1847, SHORTLY AFTERWARDS HE BUILT A SECOND BREWERY NEARBY CALLED JOHN SMITH'S. IN 1886 SAMUEL SMITH INHERITED THE EMPTY BUILDING WITH ALL EQUIPMENT HAVING BEEN MOVED TO THE NEW BREWERY. HE OPENED SAMUEL SMITH'S BREWERY UNDER HIS OWN NAME AND WAS ABLE TO COMPETE WITH THE ESTABLISHED JOHN SMITH'S BREWERY. THE SAMUEL SMITH OLD BREWERY IS BOTH THE OLDEST BREWERY IN YORKSHIRE AND THE ONLY SURVIVING INDEPENDENT BREWERY IN TADCASTER. SAMUEL SMITH'S IS ONE OF THE FEW REMAINING BRITISH BREWERIES TO EMPLOY THE TRADITIONAL YORKSHIRE SQUARE SYSTEM, A METHOD OF FERMENTATION DEVELOPED IN THE 19TH CENTURY TO CLEANSE BEER OF YEAST. BREWING WATER IS STILL DRAWN FROM THE ORIGINAL WELL, AND THE YEAST USED IN THE FERMENTATION PROCESS IS OF A STRAIN THAT HAS BEEN USED CONTINUOUSLY SINCE APPROXIMATELY 1900.

JOSEPH WEBB

JOSEPH WEBB OPENED THE FIRST COMMERCIAL BREWING OPERATION IN THE BUFFALO AREA, THE BLACK ROCK BREWERY, AROUND 1811. THE ONLY DOCUMENTED COMMERCIAL BREWERY IN THE PRE-CANAL PERIOD, THE BLACK ROCK BREWERY RELIED ON CROPS GROWN LOCALLY BY THE REGION'S FARMERS FOR ITS OPERATIONS. THERE IS NO FURTHER MENTION OF THE BREWERY AFTER 1811, BUT IT IS GENERALLY ACCEPTED THAT WEBB CONTINUED TO OPERATE UNTIL DECEMBER 1813, WHEN THE BREWERY WOULD HAVE FALLEN VICTIM TO THE BRITISH BURNING OF BLACK ROCK.
